



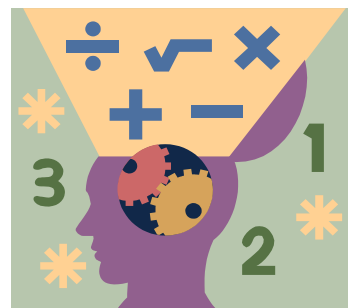
DIAGNOSIS & REMEDIATION OF LEARNING PROBLEMS IN MATHEMATICS

He is the former President and Professor of Mathematics Education at Cambridge College where he taught Mathematics for over 35 years. He is an author, teacher and teacher trainer; researcher, consultant as well as lecturer. He has been the chief editor for and Publisher of *Focus on Learning Problems in Mathematics* and international, interdisciplinary research mathematics journal with leadership in more than 90 countries, and the editor of the *Math Notebook*, a practical source of information for parents and teachers devoted to improving teaching and learning for all children. He provides direct services of evaluation and tutoring for students (children as well as adults) or face difficulties in learning mathematics. Professor Sharma works with teachers and school administrators to design strategies to improve mathematic curriculum and instruction for all.
